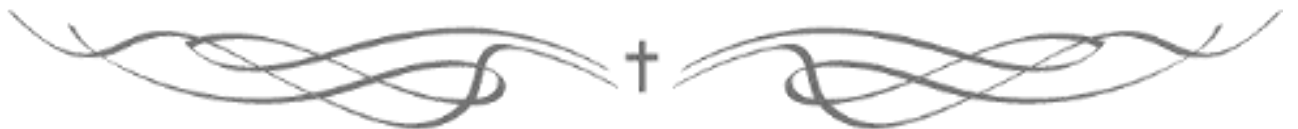

Photographic Exhibition

Following the enthusiastic reception and interest shown in the exhibition of photographic work by Waldron residents in 2016, this event will be repeated in November this year.

Entries, limited please to 4 per entrant and preferably A4 size, are again invited from anyone resident in the Waldron area or connected with the village. Following several suggestions that nominating alternative categories for entries would be helpful in stimulating ideas, this year 4 categories are proposed. These are:

Landscape and Architecture;

Portraits and People;

Still Life and Abstract;

Nature and Animals.

Hopefully it should be possible for most pictures to be placed within one of these categories.

The exhibition will be on **Saturday November 25** in All Saints church, Waldron, with reception and 'donations' bar from 2 to

6p.m. The exhibition will also be available for viewing on the 2 preceding days.

As before, there will be no fee for either exhibitors or visitors. Entries can be accepted at Rafters, Whitehouse Lane from November 1 onwards, or earlier by arrangement if necessary.
